PE and Earrings

This includes activities in their own space and where there is no risk of being hit by any equipment, such as warmups. No child will miss a PE lesson but they will be asked to participate by being involved in peer coaching and observation. Please either ask your child to remove them on the morning of your child's PE day. If you're child does wear earrings to school, these need to be small studs, again to keep children safe when active around school.
