



Polar Regions

Home Learning Challenges



Draw a picture of an animal or person who lives in the polar regions. Write some short sentences to describe them.





If 10 penguins were on an iceberg and 4 went for a swim, how many would be left on the iceberg? You could draw a picture or use your fingers to help you work out the answer.
