#### EL CLUB ESPAÑOL

Please see below a message from our Spanish club -

Hola! Are you planning a holiday to Spain or other Spanish-speaking countries this Summer? Wouldn't it be awesome if your child could speak some of the language there? Learning Spanish is a fun and useful skill and learning at primary school age gives your child the best chance of discovering a love of languages which will serve them throughout their education and life. Our FUN SPANISH Club is restarting for the Summer term and takes place on **Tuesdays**, from <u>29<sup>th</sup> April</u> for 10 weeks! These clubs take place during lunchtime for 30 minutes and the fees are £4.65 per session payable termly. Children have their lunch first at the beginning of lunchtime and then come to the club.

There is no membership fee payable until September for children joining in Summer term, then membership fee for new members is £13.95 and children receive a songbook and CD with folder and sticker chart and it includes free access to our internet gamezone and access to all the LCF French & Spanish music via streaming on any device. Sibling discounts and monthly direct debits/card payment options are available.

The club is almost filled, but there are still spaces available and you can add your child to the waiting list if full.
