- Week 2 – The whole class does art with Mrs Yarker and Mrs Platt all afternoon.



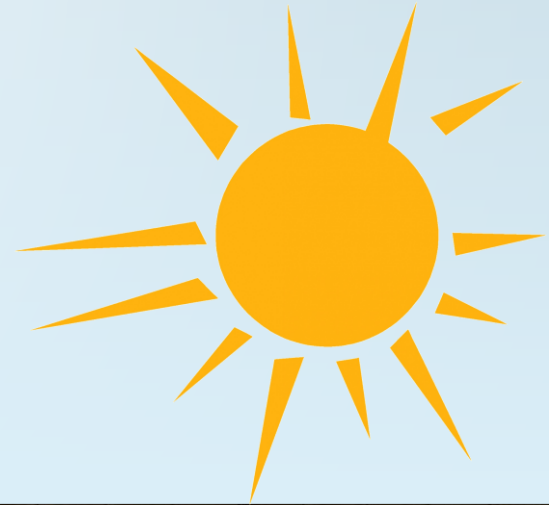
IN OUR CHRISTIAN FAMILY, WE ALL SHINE IN THE LIGHT OF JESUS.

WHAT IF RULES AREN'T BEING FOLLOWED?

- Children will be asked to stop and reflect upon their behaviour and how it makes others feel.
- If this continues, a member of staff will guide a reflection with the child to help them to understand the impact of their behaviour.



DRINKS AND SNACKS

- Please fill water bottles with water and not juice.
- Please try to send in healthy snacks (e.g. try to avoid crisps, sweets and chocolate) and make sure they are nut free.



HOMEWORK

- Homework is set each Friday to be done by the following Thursday.
- Spellings – List to be learned and an assignment to be completed on Spelling Shed. Other spelling strategies can be found on the weekly blog.
- Times tables – Specific times table to be learned each week which should be practised on TT Rockstars or using your own strategies.



READING

- Children are encouraged to read every night when possible.
- Please ask questions to your child when reading with them.
- Reading books should be brought to school every day as each child will have the opportunity to read to an adult in school at least once a week.



SWIMMING

- We will start swimming in Summer term (After Easter).
- Everyone will need a swimming cap and towel and a named bag for life to carry everything in.
- Boys will need dark coloured swimming shorts or trunks.
- Girls will need full swimming costumes.



PE

- Every child must have full PE kit in school every day. This includes black shorts, blue t-shirt and trainers or pumps.
- PE lessons are on Tuesdays and Fridays.
- If your child wears ear rings, please ensure they can take them out themselves. If they can't please do not put them in on PE days.

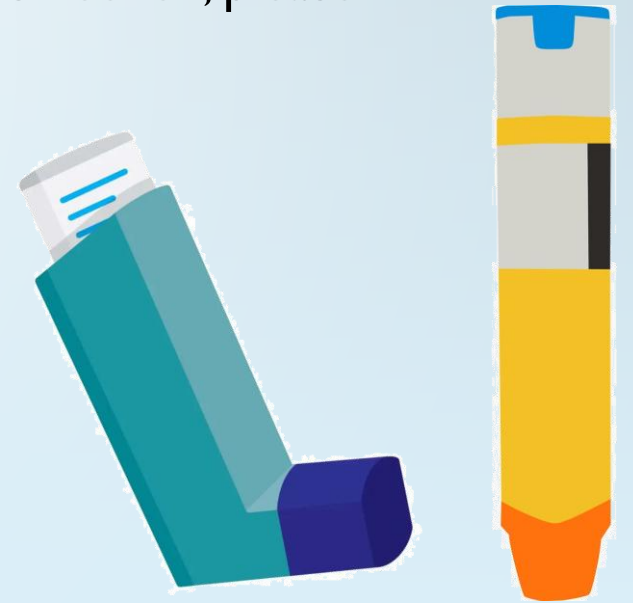


END OF DAY ROUTINE

- Please continue to wait on the playground for your child. We really appreciate you waiting a little longer whilst your children get used to new routines.
- Children will only be allowed home with adults on their safeguarding list unless school has been contacted.
- If your child has had medication, you will need to wait until all children have been dismissed to sign the medication form.
- If you would like to speak to me at the end of the day, please also wait until all children have been dismissed.

MEDICATION

- If your child receives a new diagnosis during the year (e.g. asthma or allergies), please inform school straight away and provide the relevant medication to be kept in school.
- We can not keep one off medication (e.g. calpol) in school, so if this is needed, please only send the correct amount for that day (sachets, not bottles).
