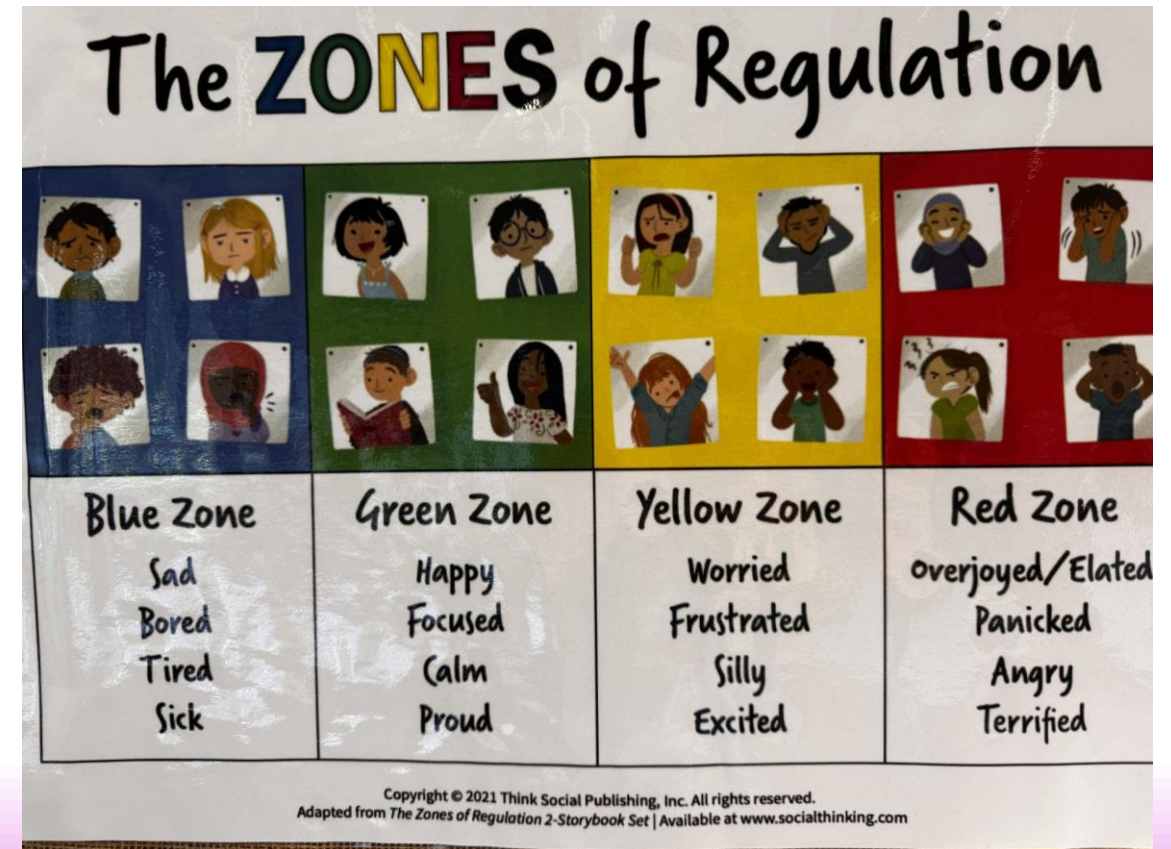
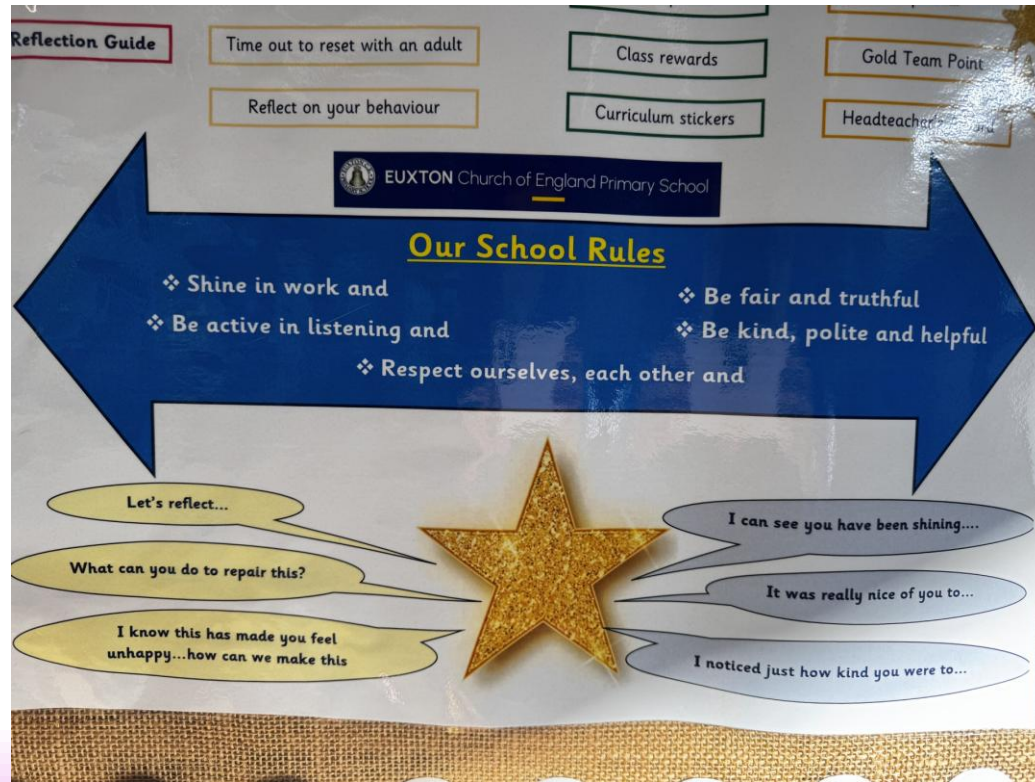

# Homework and reading.

Children should all now have their reading records and a banded book to take home. Please send these in daily as we will aim to read with your child as often as we can during the week. We appreciate books in the juniors can now take longer to finish so we will not have set days to changes books this year. Instead, your child can bring your book to us when they need it changing and we will do this as and when.

We do remind them each morning but just catch one of us if their books are not being changed.



# PE
