Staff are always available to talk to if needed which is great and you are made to feel very welcome to contact them which is great. I would recommend this school to anyone as it really is a lovely school with a welcoming and friendly feel. All the children seem happy and content here which really is the most important thing when it comes to school and we can't wait to see how our daughter progresses in this first year.

Our child has settled really well into reception and the school generally. The school have communicated very impressively from receiving a place, providing a settling in session for the class before the summer break and a Zoom session for the parents. All the staff are very friendly and helpful, and are available to speak to on a daily basis. We receive a weekly newsletter to keep up to date on all aspects of school life. Parents are invited to zoom curriculum meetings and a new app is now available to share children's work to home, aswell as completed work brought home to show any achievements. Our child is very happy and his confidence is growing with each day. He is encouraged to be proud of his achievements and I feel there is a very positive vibe to each pupil every day. Wonderful Wednesdays are looked forward to each week There is also a strong Christian ethos to the school with a daily worship at the start of each day.
